

CAN I GET ADVICE FROM OTHER PROFESSIONALS? (EARLY INTERVENTION SERVICES)

Many children with a disability can benefit from some type of early therapy. For example: Occupational Therapy can help with motor skills such as playing, dressing and going to the toilet. Physiotherapy can help with balance, sitting, rolling, crawling and walking. Speech therapy can help with speech and language, as well as eating and drinking skills. Early intervention often combines specialist support and therapies. These organisations can link you to services in your local area

NEED TIME OUT... How do I arrange this?

Respite care is when someone looks after you as the patient, or your child with additional needs. Respite care can be for a few hours during the day. It can also be overnight or for longer periods like a few weeks. You might use respite care occasionally or on a regular basis. The respite care can take place in your home or somewhere else.



Booking and Payment Service provides interpreters for Deaf, Deafblind and hard of hearing people who use sign language and would like an interpreter for private health care appointments. Sign language services to Deaf people are provided for both public and private health care appointments. An interpreter can be booked if the appointment is for a Deaf adult or a Deaf child. This includes situations where there is a Deaf adult and a hearing child or a hearing adult and a Deaf child attending a private health care appointment. Services include face to face interpreting (onsite) and Video Remote Interpreting (online). NABS services are not free for people who have an NDIS Plan or who are eligible for NDIS.
